

Aunt and Uncle Family Volunteer Description

Duties:

1. Responsible for initiating contact with intern via phone or planned activity.
2. Be available to provide transportation (when possible) for your intern (assuming they call).
3. Be available to the intern during their transition from the first host family to the second host family.
4. Interact and work with the host family; for example, check in on the interns when the host family is on vacation.

Skills Required:

1. Families with time and willingness to support the intern and host family.

Time Commitment:

1. Family should plan to contact the intern at least once a month. Time can vary depending on how active an aunt and uncle family would like to be, or their availability to help out with transportation.
2. Length of commitment would be from the time the intern arrives until the last day of school (roughly September to mid-June).

Benefits include the opportunity to:

1. Learn about a different culture.
2. Help a young adult learn about the American culture.
3. Connect with an individual that works with your children.
4. Connect with other PSI families.
5. Support the Amity Program and build school community.
